Join the man himself as he, his wife Jean, a cast of local characters, musicians and a chorus of singers, take you back in time to the 'Dumfries Years' (1788 to 1796). Walk in his footsteps on the cobbles where he trod and hear him breathe with the passion and clarity of spirit that characterises his work and his time here, a time of inspiration, radical political views, of excise tales, friendships and prolific song.

More than an historic trail, this new play by John Cairney captures the raw truth behind one of the greatest artists ever to have lived and invites you to celebrate his words, music and life in the places where he lived, loved, worked and drew his final breath.

Be with us from the start of what promises to become a major annual event marking the day Robert Burns died in Dumfries aged 37 on 21st July 1796 - a truly special celebration and inspiration for the town, its people and its welcome visitors.
